

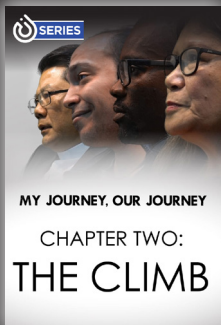

- What are things you can control to support migrants and refugees?



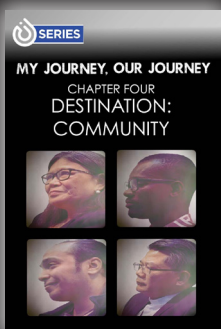
Chapter two: The Climb
